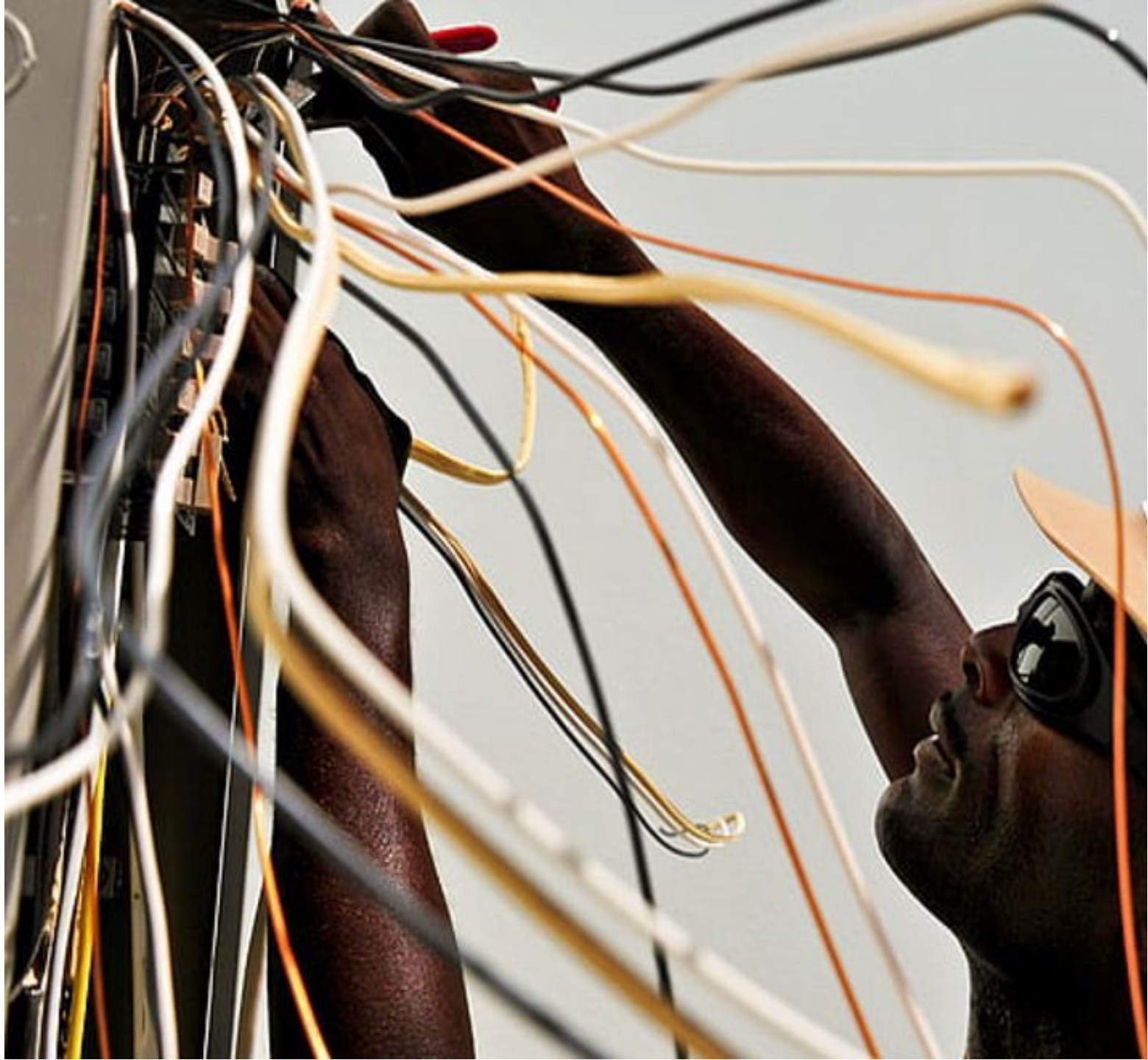

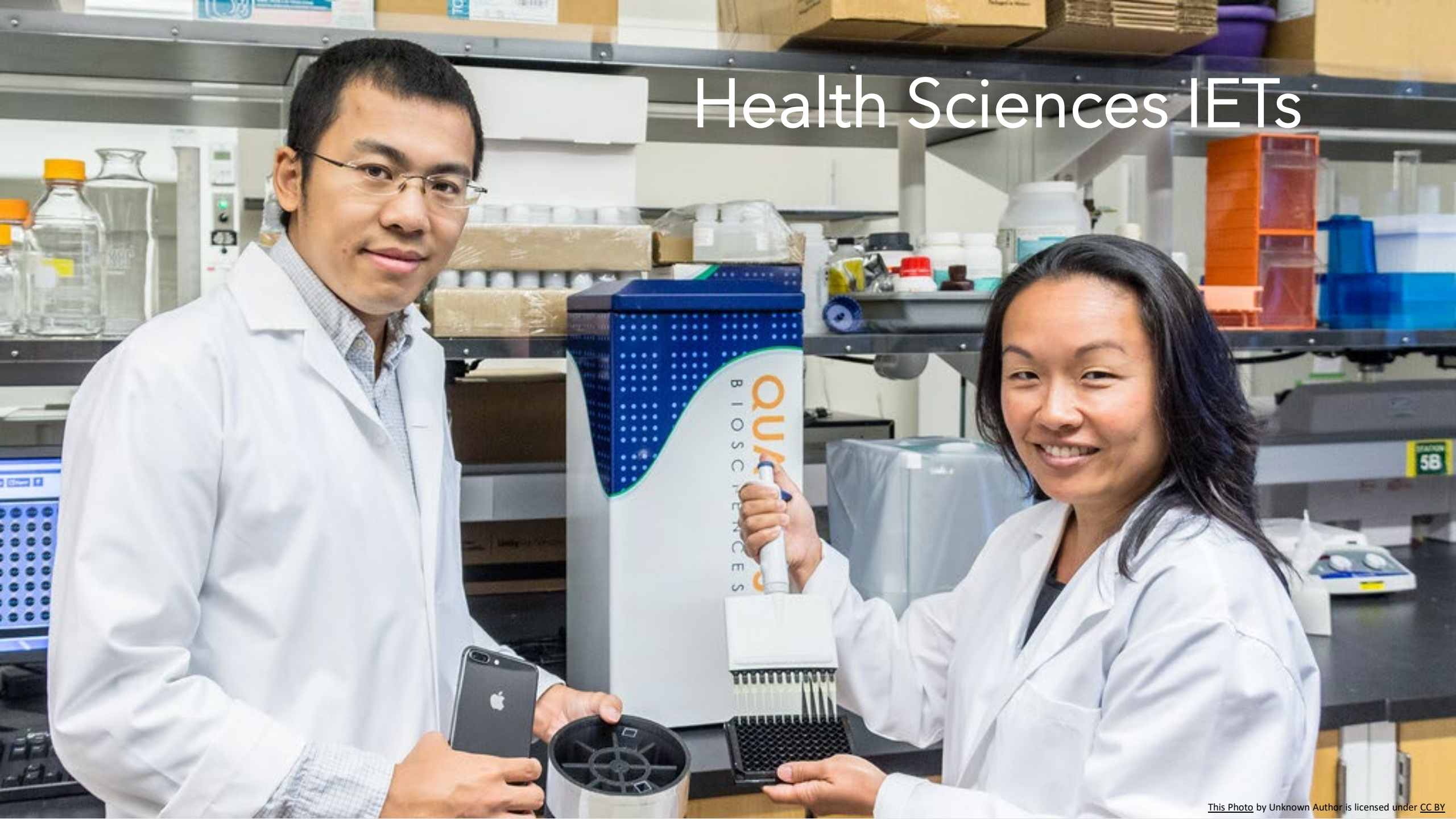

Personal Care Aide

What does a Personal Care Aide do?

A PCA (Personal Care Aide) provides direct care such as bathing, grooming, dressing, and toileting. They may help with eating or exercise. PCAs work in Assisted Living communities and for Home Health Care agencies. A PCA is similar to a Nurse Aide but it is less clinical; the clients need less assistance.

In this program you will learn:

- Basic home management skills to help clients live in their homes independently
- Personal care skills to help people need assistance
- Communication skills to provide safe, high-quality care.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Social Security Number
- Able to pass a criminal background check
- ESL 6/ABE 2 or higher



Nurse Aide IET

(Integrated Education & Training)

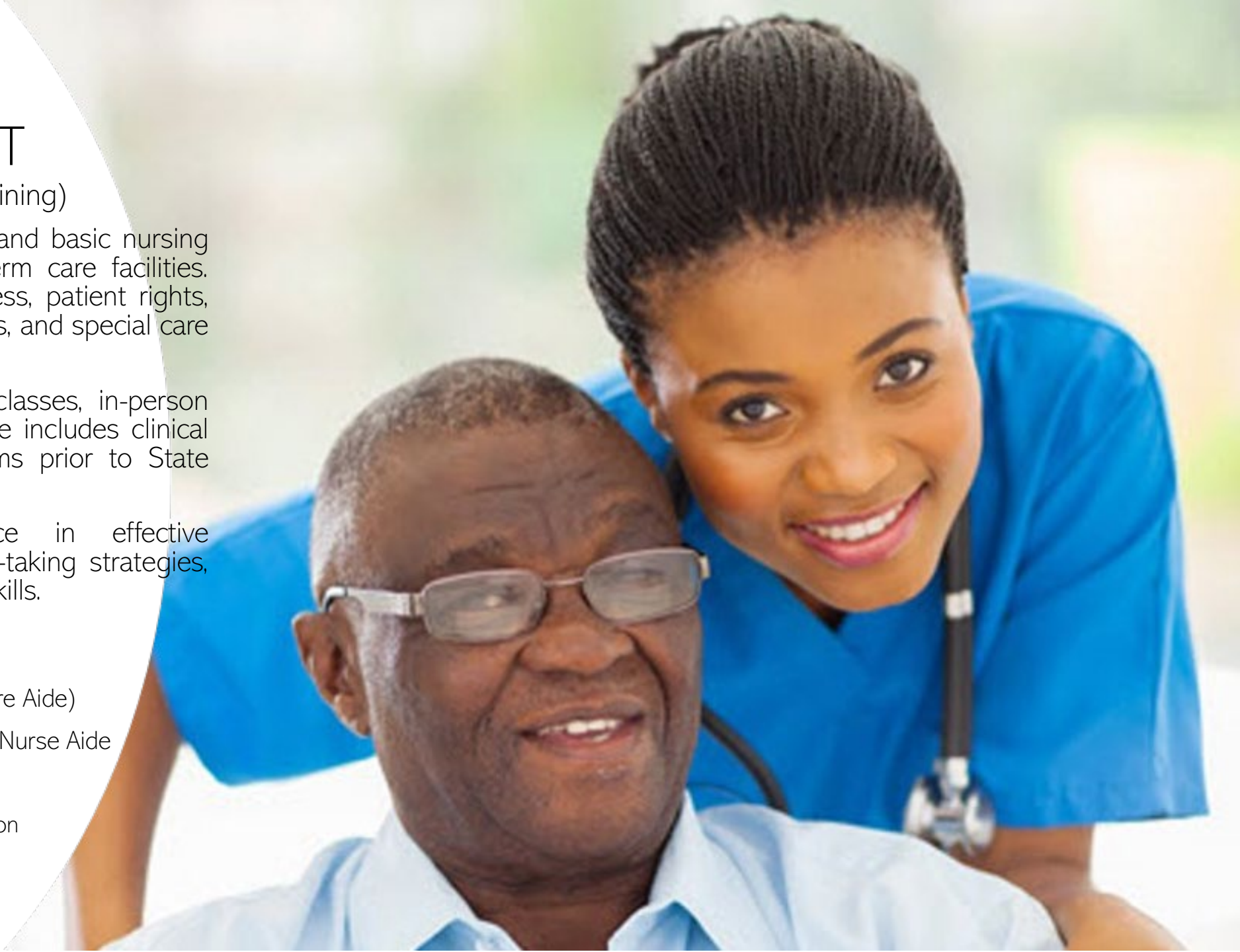
Learn to provide personal care and basic nursing care to people living in long-term care facilities. Emphasis is on the aging process, patient rights, safe and restorative environments, and special care procedures.

Includes virtual and in-person classes, in-person labs, and clinical rotation. Course includes clinical skills exam and academic exams prior to State exam.

IET classes include practice in effective communication, studying & test-taking strategies, and developing critical thinking skills.

Requirements

- ❖ Certification as PCA (Personal Care Aide)
- ❖ Working as a PCA while studying Nurse Aide
- ❖ BLS CPR certification
 - ❖ Current through clinical rotation
- ❖ ABE 3 or higher



EKG Technician IET

(Integrated Education & Training)

Become a Certified EKG Technician
and a Certified Cardiographic
Technician

- Learn to set up EKG and stress tests
- Prepare patients for Holter or ambulatory monitoring
- Edit and deliver final results to physicians for analysis
- Transcribe physician's interpretations

Central Sterile Processing Technician

You will learn:

- Sterilization & Disinfection
- Storage & Distribution of instruments

Phlebotomist

You will learn:

- To collect blood specimens for lab tests
- Venipunctures, finger sticks, and heel sticks
- To manage, process, and transport blood specimens

You will prepare for the exam from:

- American Society of Clinical Pathology

High school diploma or HSE required (from any country)

ABE 3 or higher

Health Sciences Preparation

- Pre-IET
- Required before applying to HS IETs
 - EKG Technician
 - Central Sterile Processing Technician
 - Phlebotomy
- Deep dive into Medical Terminology
- Detailed exploration of identified career pathways
- Must be ABE 3 or higher





Basic IET Information

- All IETs require 90% attendance
 - This includes arriving on time and staying until the end of every class in the program
 - This is required for the certificates and is non-negotiable
 - If a student cannot commit to at least 90% attendance, they should wait until their schedule allows for the commitment
- IETs require homework and independent studying
 - Homework is graded and required
 - Tests and quizzes require studying
- When the IET has ended, the students return to regular CCR classes
- Financial sponsorship includes
 - Tuition
 - Books & materials

IETs are a big commitment. Students are not expected or required to remain in ESL or ABE classes during an IET. You will return to your ESL or ABE classes after you complete the IET.
