Thank you for your letter of April 30, 2012, providing notification that, effective fall 2012, several programs will be terminated and providing notification that over 50% of the A.A.S. degree in Accounting will be offered at the previously approved Western Wake Campus, effective fall 2012.

Human Services Technology: Developmental Disabilities Associate Degree and Certificate

This program is offered at the approved Health Sciences Campus (2901 Holston Lane, Raleigh, NC 27610). Currently only two students are enrolled in the degree program and no students are enrolled in the certificate program. The two students have been given the option of transferring to the Human Services Technology associate degree program. Faculty members will not be adversely affected since they also teach in the Human Services Technology associate degree program.

We approve the termination of the above listed program and request no further information.

Human Services Technology: Services for the Aging Certificate

This program is offered at the approved Health Sciences Campus (2901 Holston Lane, Raleigh, NC 27610). Currently no students are enrolled in the program and no new students have been enrolled, effective summer 2012. Faculty members will not be adversely affected since they also teach in the Human Services Technology associate degree program.

We approve the termination of the above listed program and request no further information.

Human Services Technology Certificate

This program is offered at the approved Health Sciences Campus (2901 Holston Lane, Raleigh, NC 27610). The certificate no longer meets entry level position requirements. The five students currently enrolled in the program have been given the option to transfer into the Human Services Technology degree program. No new students were enrolled, effective summer 2012. Faculty members will not be adversely affected since they also teach in the Human Services Technology associate degree program.

Offering of 50% or more of the A.A.S. degree in Accounting at the Western Wake Campus (3434 Kildaire Farm Road, Cary, NC 27518)
