Learn to properly inspect mechanical installations in all residential and commercial construction through an understanding of the NC Building Code's mechanical and fuel gas codes. Each level has a certification with an increased code knowledge and responsibility.

Plumbing Standard Inspection, Levels 1, 2 and 3

Learn to properly inspect plumbing installations in all residential and commercial construction through an understanding of the North Carolina Building Code's plumbing code. Each level has a certification with an increased code knowledge and responsibility.

Certification for each of the Standard Inspection levels is accomplished by successfully completing the appropriate coursework along with other requirements of the NC Code Officials Qualification Board and passing the state exam for that level.



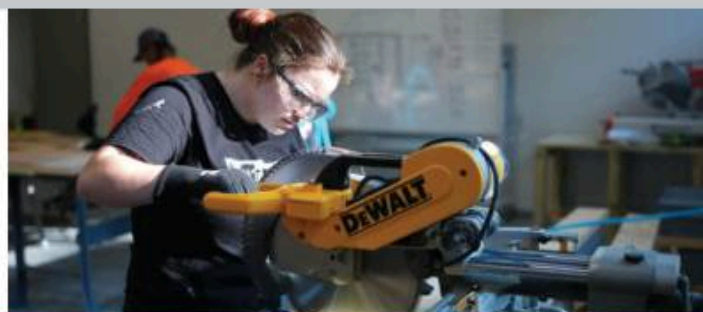
OSHA

OSHA 10-Hour Training
