

## English Language Requirement Form

All health care workers (native and non-native US English speakers alike) are expected to use clear communication skills in the workplace. Students whose native language is not US English are expected to demonstrate "near native" US English language abilities for both academic success in nursing as well as patient safety.

Applicants whose native language is not English, and who did not graduate from a high school in the United States, will be required to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).

To confirm this ability, all students entering the Nursing Program (ADN/LPN) are required to meet the English language requirement and submit an English Language Requirement Form with their application.
