EVENT: Read, Lead, & Network: Nice Girls Don't Get the Corner Office

DATE (s): March 12, 13, and 14, 2019

In celebration of Women's History Month, the "Read, Lead & Network" professional development sessions focus on women in the workplace. Programming Work Group Chair, Laveda Joseph, coordinated the event series, which was designed around the book "Nice Girls Don't Get the Corner Office" by Dr. Lois Frankel. The events took place at Wake Tech's Southern Wake, Scott Northern Wake, and Research Triangle Park Campuses.

Using the book's self-assessment tool as a starting point, participants shared how the book helped them recognize how some of the subtle behaviors that are engrained in us as girls can be detrimental to our leadership advancement as women. After sharing insights into these "nice girls' behaviors", a discussion ensued to give women in the room the opportunity to network with members of the Wake Tech Chapter of the AAWCC who attended the event.
