Degree (Credit) vs. Non-Degree (Non-Credit)

Workforce Continuing Education (WCE) courses are considered "non-credit." When you take a WCE course, you won't earn college credit towards a degree (except in some unique cases) — but, you can earn industry-recognized certifications and CEUs.

Require high school transcript	Don't require high school transcript
Longer term	Shorter term

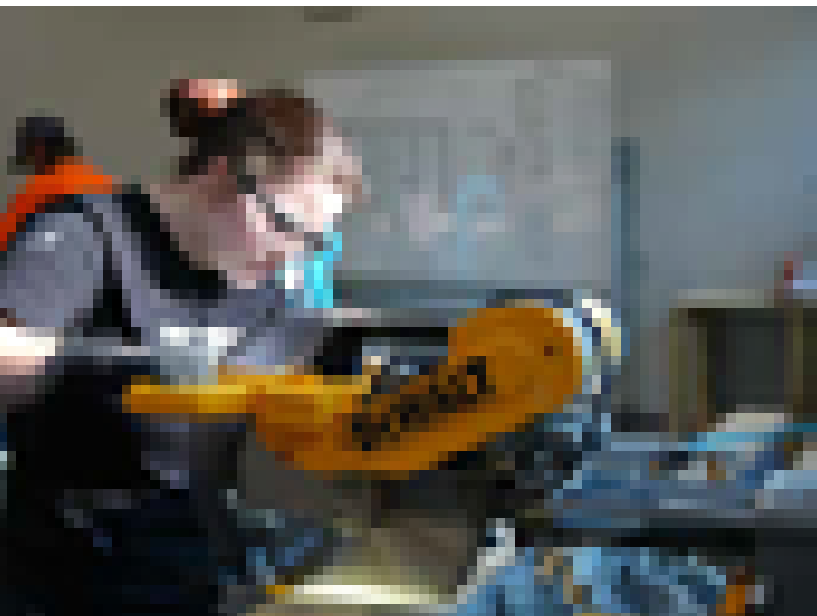

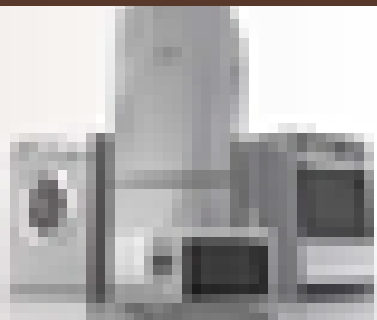
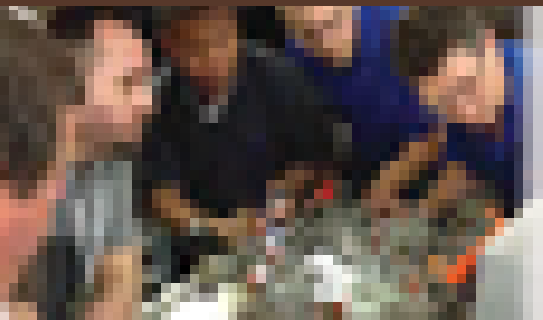

Certified Fiber-Optic Technician Training

Develop the skills required for entry-level employment as a technician in a fiber-optic or telecommunications company. Cover the fundamental principles of fiber-optic technology, cable termination, networks, splicing procedures, troubleshooting and testing equipment.

You'll follow safety standards and protocols as you learn how to terminate fiber-optic cables, perform a mechanical and fusion splice, and learn how to calculate a system loss budget. Learn how to construct, test, and troubleshoot cabling systems using an Optical Time Domain

Reflectometer (OTDR) and how to operate a Fusion Splicer.

Upon satisfactory course completion, you'll be eligible to take the Fiber Optic Association (FOA®) Certified Fiber-Optic Technician (CFOT®) certification exam, a nationally recognized certification.

Registered Behavior Technician Certificate Training

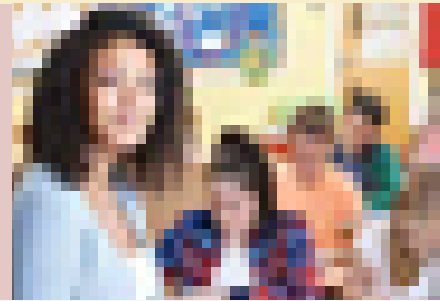


Learn principles and strategies for working with adults and children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Gain an understanding of ASD and learn best practices for assisting individuals with functional communication acquisition, social skill development, and behavior change.

Also learn about Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), an empirically validated method for changing behaviors and teaching social and adaptive living skills. Successful completion of the course results in a certificate of completion for the 40-hour Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) course, which can lead to certification as an RBT from the Behavior Analysis Certification Board (BACB).

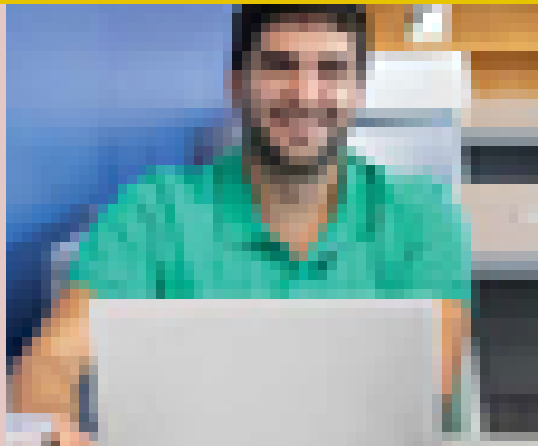

Building Standard Inspection, I, II and III

Learn to properly inspect residential and commercial construction through an understanding of the NC Building Code, beginning with Level I, as each Level has a Certification with an increased scope of code knowledge and responsibility.

Electrical Standard Inspection, I, II and III

Learn to properly inspect electrical installations in all residential and commercial construction through an understanding of the NC Electrical Code of the NC Building Code, beginning with Level I, as each Level has a Certification with an increased code knowledge and responsibility.

Mechanical Standard Inspection, I, II and III

Learn to properly inspect mechanical installations in all residential and commercial construction through an understanding of the NC Mechanical and Fuel Gas Code of the NC Building Code, beginning with Level 1, as each Level has a Certification with an increased code knowledge and responsibility.

Plumbing Standard Inspection, I, II and III

Learn to properly inspect plumbing installations in all residential and commercial construction through an understanding of the NC Plumbing Code of the NC Building Code, beginning with Level 1, as each Level has a Certification with an increased code knowledge and responsibility.

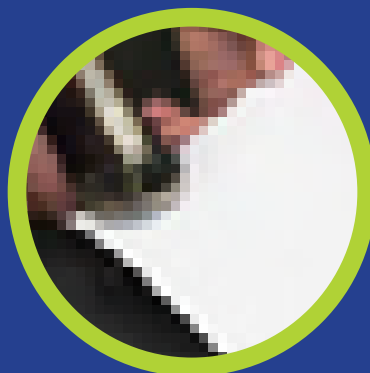
Certification for each of the Standard Inspection Levels is accomplished by successfully completing the appropriate coursework along with other requirements of the NC Code Officials Qualification Board and passing the state exam for that level.



OSHA 10-Hour Training

This 10-hour program helps entry-level construction workers learn how to recognize and prevent hazards on a construction site. The course is an ideal orientation for workers who are new to construction – and an excellent reminder of workplace hazards for those who've been in the industry for some time.

Notary Public Education



Become a notary public in NC. Learn the legal, ethical, and procedural requirements for notaries according to NC laws.

This course is approved by the NC Secretary of State to train, test, qualify, and commission NC notaries. The course covers the legal, ethical, and procedural requirements for notaries in NC.

NOTE: 100% attendance and satisfactory class participation are required; late students may not be admitted.



Thinking of a healthcare career?

Medical Terminology

This course introduces medical terminology and is a PREREQUISITE for a variety of courses. You'll learn terminology for the anatomy and physiology of all body systems, pharmacology, and major diseases as well as terms used in exams, procedures, and diagnoses. *Also offered online.*

Clinical Research Specialist

Prepare to work in clinical research. Learn about clinical trial structure, regulatory requirements, and the basics of collecting and analyzing data. Upon completion, students will understand clinical research concepts and structure and be able to apply that knowledge in a clinical trial or research setting. *Also offered online.*

Certified Healthcare Billing and Coding Specialist, Parts 1 and 2

Part 1: Prepare for entry-level healthcare billing positions and the CMRS exam. Train on insurance claims, legal and regulatory considerations, insurance plans, Medicare, Workers' Comp, and more.

Part 2: Prepare for coding careers and the CPC exam. Cover the roles and responsibilities of coders, regulations, and managed healthcare.

Intro to Medical Sonography

This course is part of Wake Tech's competitive entry process for the program. Topics covered in the course include applications, terminology, history, patient care, ethics and basic skills. Upon completion, students should also be able to define sonographic applications, basic patient care skills and preliminary scanning techniques.

IONM Review

This course is offered to both graduates of an EDT program and EDT professionals to prepare for their CNIM exam. The course is lecture-only and is fully online to allow students from across the region to participate. Principles covered follow the practice analysis for the CNIM provided by ABRET, including preparation and application of fundamental concepts, intraoperative phase, post-operative phase, and more!

Mammography

This course is for American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT)-registered radiologic technologists and radiography students. The theory component of the course is online and covers the principles of breast anatomy, positioning, projections, processing, quality control and evaluation of digital images. Upon completion of the required clinical rotation, you may be eligible to take the ARRT post-primary certification exam in mammography.

Emergency Medical Technician



Learn the concepts of basic emergency medical care, including airway, patient assessment, emergencies, trauma, pediatrics, and operations.
