Wake Technical Community College will close the Certificate I and Certificate II programs in Therapeutic Massage, effective May 17, 2021. Beginning fall 2021, Therapeutic Massage will be offered through Workforce Continuing Education.

The students, faculty, and staff members associated with the programs were notified of the closures by email or in online meetings. Students have been offered the opportunity to complete the certificates or transfer to other programs. Currently enrolled students were expected to complete the programs by May 11, 2021. Students will not incur additional expenses due to the closures. Faculty, staff, and equipment associated with the programs will be redeployed to the institution's Workforce Continuing Education Division.

The Board of Trustees of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges approves the closure of the Certificate I and Certificate II programs in Therapeutic Massage.
