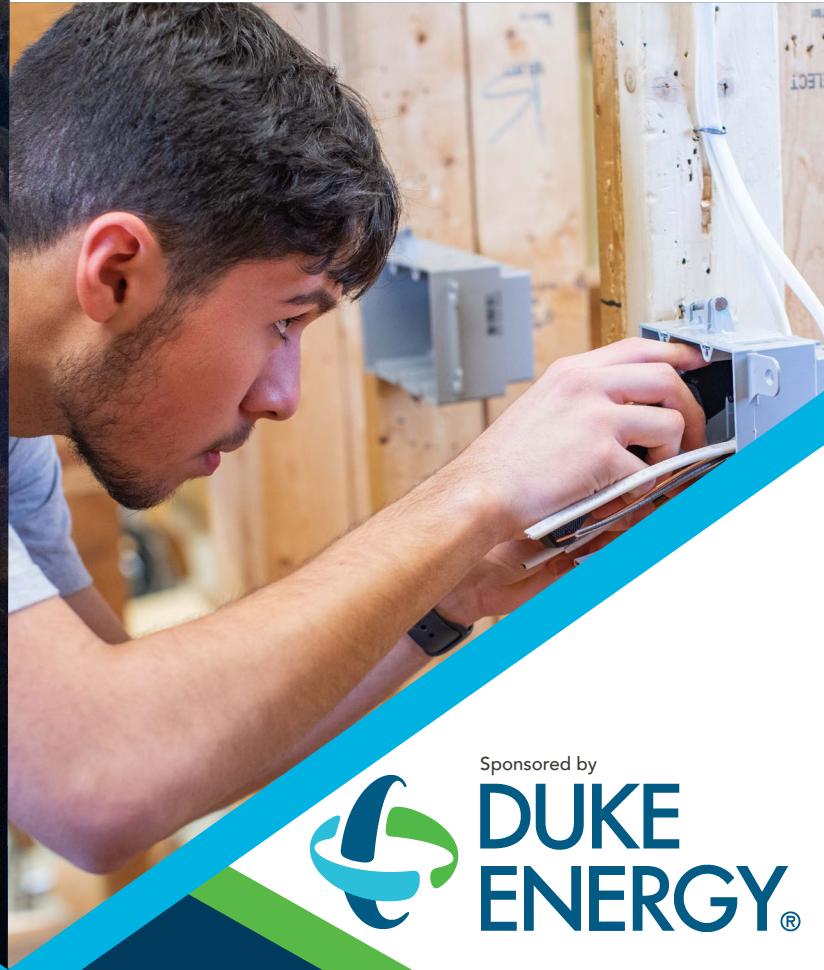

Power Up Your Future with Duke Energy Technology Scholarships.

The Applied Engineering and Technologies Division (AET) at Wake Tech has been awarded a Duke Energy Opportunity Grant (DEOG) to provide scholarships for new students in the following programs:

- Civil Engineering Technology
- Electrical Systems Technology
- Electronics Engineering Technology
- Geomatics Technology
- Heavy Equipment Operation
- Mechanical Engineering Technology
- Welding Technology

Who Can Apply for a Scholarship?

All new part-time or full-time students in the above programs can apply for these technology scholarships, with priority given to women and underrepresented groups. Students may receive up to \$1,000 for the first semester — and up to another \$1,000 for the second semester, if students remain in good academic standing and continue in an approved program.

Are There Other Forms of Assistance?

The DEOG provides Hardship Assistance for students facing expenses which could prevent them from continuing their education. This grant also offers Certificate Reimbursement for industry standard certifications paid for by the student. All AET students may apply for either of these awards.
