TICKETS

Each participating graduate will receive **4 admission tickets** for their guests. Tickets are given during regalia pick up. Tickets are required to gain entrance into the ceremony.

Do children need admission tickets? Yes. Every guest requires a ticket, including children, regardless of age.

Do graduates need admission tickets? No. Graduates do not need tickets.

Can a graduate request additional tickets? No, there is no option for additional tickets.

ON GRADUATION DAY:

Arrive early – at least 1 hour before your ceremony start time to allow for parking, check in and lineup. <u>There is no rehearsal</u>. If you arrive late, you will not be permitted to enter the processional line to participate.

Dress appropriately in dressy or business casual clothing underneath your graduation gown. Graduates without proper attire will not be allowed to participate. Appropriate footwear is advised as you will be standing for periods of time during processional lineup.

Do not bring personal belongings. Storage is not available. **All you need is your regalia.**

Act appropriately. Graduates or guests whose behavior detracts from the dignity and importance of the occasion will not be allowed to participate.

WHERE WILL I GET IN LINE?

Upon arrival at building N, graduates will enter through the covered entrance on Winning Way and guests will be directed to the gymnasium entrance. There will be Wake Tech personnel and signs to guide everyone. Graduates: check in on arrival and receive your "name call card". Bring a photo ID in order to get checked in quickly.

After you receive your name call card, there will be additional signs and personnel to guide you to your lineup area.

<u>Keep up with your card</u>; you'll need it to give to the reader who will call your name as you walk across the stage.

HOW WILL GRADUATES ENTER THE CEREMONY?

You will be seated with the division that corresponds to your major. Marshals will lead the lines as needed.

In order to prevent distraction during the ceremony, graduates should remain in the graduate seating area after they walk across the stage. We ask that you do not leave the ceremony after you receive your diploma cover.

HOW LONG DOES THE CEREMONY LAST?

The ceremony typically lasts one hour, and starts on time. We ask that your guests arrive early so they can be seated before the ceremony begins. Guests will experience delays in entrance if they arrive late.

WILL PHOTOGRAPHS BE TAKEN?

Professional photographs will be taken of each graduate on stage and made available for purchase after graduation. Graduates will receive a free color proof with a password for viewing photos online. They can arrange to receive email notification when photos are posted by visiting

www.photospecialties.com and preregistering. Students who do not receive a proof within one week should contact info@photospecialties.com or call 1-800-722-7033. Guests will not be allowed in the graduate seating area to take pictures or videos during the ceremony. After the ceremony, you are welcome to go outside, by the Congratulations banner to take pictures with your family and friends.
