



As a limited enrollment program, the Dental Hygiene program has a selective, competitive admission process and includes additional requirements over and above standard admission to Wake Tech Community College. Please make sure you have met all requirements below before submitting your Dental Hygiene program application.

	Complete the mandatory Dental Hygiene information session. 	Shadowing. Form attached to the Dental Hygiene program application. Complete 20 hours (unpaid) of shadowing a Registered Dental Hygienist within the application year. Ex. January 1, 2024-January 31, 2025.
	GPA requirement : Wake Tech pre-Dental Hygiene program GPA must be a 2.0 or higher to submit application.
	Submit Dental Hygiene program application and applicable supporting documentation:
	☐ The Dental Hygiene program application period is August 1 through January 31. Please note that applications will not be accepted before August 1 or after January 31. Applicants with equal point totals will be selected by using the highest score on the Admission Test for Dental Hygiene (ATDH) Perceptual Ability Score. If a tie still exists, the highest ATDH Quantitative Reasoning Score will be utilized. Finally, if a tie remains, the ATDH Overall Score will be used to break the tie.
	 Include documentation for the 20 hours of shadowing a Dental Hygienist. If you currently work in a dental office, the 20 hours of job shadowing must be UNPAID hours.
	\Box Take the ATDH by the application deadline. Ensure that Wake Tech is listed as a recipient of your score report.

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2025 Competitive Admissions Process

Applicants are assigned points for non-clinical (non-DEN) courses that are part of the Associate of Applied Science Dental Hygiene curriculum and are completed by the application deadline.

- Points will be accrued for classes completed within 5 years of the application window (ex. 2019-2024 if applying for August 2025). Only those applicants who have completed the minimum admissions requirements and returned all required forms by the deadline will be considered eligible to be ranked for acceptance to register for DEN classes.
- Points will be awarded based on scores earned by taking the Admissions Test for Dental Hygiene administered by the American Dental Association. More information can be found on the <u>ADA website</u>.
- 2 (two) points will be awarded for dental assistants that have graduated from a Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) program or are a Certified Dental Assistant. (CDA)
- 2 (two) points will be awarded for certification/graduation from select Allied Health disciplines as determined by the Dental Hygiene department head.
- Points will be awarded for attendance at our existing Dental Hygiene Boot Camp. HRD3004WC2
- Points will be awarded for completing the CE course Career Exploration in Dental Hygiene. HRD3004CR2

HUMANITIES/FINE ARTS ELECTIVE: The Humanities elective can be any 3 credit hour class focusing on religion, art, literature, philosophy, drawing, sculpting, painting, music, dance, and theatre. Only 1 (one) class is required. Speak with an advisor for other choices.

Points will be awarded for courses taken at Wake Technical Community College or any U.S. regionally accredited institution and that meet the established transfer criteria established by the academic department. A grade of "C" or better must be earned in order to receive transfer credit. **Technical Core courses (CHM 130, BIO 163, BIO 175) must be completed within 5 years of the application window.** (ex. 2019-2024 if applying for August 2025)

Since letter grades are not given to students who pass a challenge examination (AP/CLEP), points will be awarded for courses that have been challenged by assigning a grade of "B".

Applicants who wish to transfer from another institution must follow the criteria noted on the Transfer Student Policy document. Points may be deducted in the competitive process based on the reason for the transfer.

Only those applicants who have completed the minimum admissions requirements and returned all required forms by the deadline will be considered eligible to be ranked for the DEN classes.
