ARP / HEERF III Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants

Wake Technical Community College signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the US Department of Education offering assurance that the college intends to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students on April 15, 2020. The college received an American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) Grant Award Notification from the US Department of Education on May 17, 2021 in the amount of \$19,645,996 for Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants and accepted the terms and conditions as outlined.

Status of Distribution of Funds

As of June 30, 2021, Wake Tech has distributed \$0 to zero students in ARP/HEERF III Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSAA. During this period, students received Emergency Financial Aid Grants from CRRSAA/HEERF II funds.

Eligibility

Approximately 26,204 Wake Tech students (credit and non-credit) are eligible for ARP/HEERF III Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants.

Methodology
