



Instructions for Wake Tech Students Attending Another Institution through CRC

To be eligible to take a CRC course, you must:

- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Be enrolled for at least 9 credit hours at Wake Tech for the semester
- Not be in your first semester at Wake Tech
- Have satisfied all developmental course requirements
- Be enrolled in a degree-seeking program at Wake Tech

To register for a CRC Course:

1. Meet with an academic advisor and complete a [CRC application](#).
 - To retrieve the CRC application, go to tinyurl.com/crcapprovalform.
2. Meet with the dean of your academic program for approval of transfer credit:
 - Please note: While a course may transfer to Wake Tech, it may or may not fall into the requirements for your program. Please discuss how the course will transfer and apply to your requirements with the dean.
3. Submit your completed application (with both signatures from an advisor and dean):
 - Your CRC application may be scanned and e-mailed to jharris17@waketech.edu or presented in person to the Registrar's office at the Southern or Northern campuses.
 - Please make sure you have a phone number and email address listed on your application.
4. Your application will be forwarded to the institution by the Registrar's office. The institution will contact you directly via email regarding your application.

To withdraw from a CRC Course:

You must notify the Wake Tech Registrar's office by emailing jharris17@waketech.edu. The Registrar will ask the other institution to remove your name from the course roster.

Additional Information for Wake Tech CRC students:

- You may take up to two CRC courses per semester.
- You will be notified via email of ANY updates regarding your CRC application.
- You can NOT take online or distance learning courses or summer courses through CRC.
- You will be charged tuition at Wake Tech; however, you will be responsible for student fees (including lab fees, art fees, etc.) and any books or supplies required for the CRC course. These expenses are NOT covered by Financial Aid.
