The clinical admissions procedure for Medical Assisting is a two-part process utilizing both a first-come, first-served process and class completion. This procedure is used if there are more applicants who have met the minimum admission requirements (MAR) than there are available clinical spaces. Those applicants with the most general courses completed and with the earliest clinical application submission date will be selected for the available clinical slots.

General Courses: Applicants can take the general education courses in the Medical Assisting curriculum prior to beginning the MED classes. These classes include **ENG 111, MAT 110, CIS 111,** and **BIO 161**. Completion of each class with a "C" or better is worth one (1) point. Students with the most points and the earliest clinical application date will have a higher priority for acceptance into the Medical Assisting program and permitted to register for the MED courses.

Please note that Wake Technical Community College is constantly evaluating the admissions procedures and reserves the right to make changes as the need arises.

Once an applicant has been offered a full-time space in the Medical Assisting program, he/she must complete the following:

- Submit a completed Wake Tech Physical Evaluation form
- Submit an "Addendum to the Application for Admissions" and provide Criminal Background Check to the college
- Begin Hepatitis B immunizations
- · Become certified in CPR (Healthcare Provider Course or Adult, Child, and Infant Course)
- · Secure professional liability insurance (charged to Health Sciences students as a fee to pay with tuition)
- Complete required drug testing panels
- Some clinical sites require that students obtain and maintain health insurance coverage during the clinical component of their program of study. Students who are accepted into the clinical portion of their program will be given more information and instructions about this requirement at program orientation sessions.
