The project supports the Smithsonian and Library of Congress crowdsourcing campaign to transcribe thousands of letters, speeches, articles, diaries and other suffragist documents. Join the fun! The suffrage transcription campaign coincides with the 100th anniversary of the 19th Amendment, which was passed by Congress in June 1919 and ratified in August 1920.
