To be eligible for enrollment, high school students must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ be a HS junior or senior;
- √ have a unweighted 2.8 GPA on high school courses or have a recommendation of the high school principal or his/her designee;
- ✓ meet the prerequisites for the career pathway; and
- ✓ be making progress toward HS graduation.

To maintain eligibility to continued enrollment, a student must:

- ✓ continue to make progress toward HS graduation; and
- ✓ maintain a minimum ĞPA of 2.0 in college coursework after completing courses after completing 2 course at Wake Tech.

Articulated course: Courses designated AC are part of the State CTE articulation agreement. Courses designated LAC are part of a local articulation agreement between Wake Technical Community College and our LEA partners. Students may receive college credit for this high school course by meeting the following criteria: Grade of B or higher in the high school course AND a scale score of 93 or higher on the CTE post-assessment. To receive articulate credit, students must enroll at the community college within two years of high school graduation date.
