What Is Barbering?

Barbering consist of haircutting, shaving, trimming the beard, coloring the hair, applying hair tonics, permanent waving, facial and scalp massages, treatments with oils, creams, lotions or other preparations either by hand or mechanical appliances.

Training Leading to Certification

Learn the art of barbering, and prepare for the N.C. Board of Barber Examiners certification exam and apprentice license.

After at least one year of on-the-job training another examination is given by the Barber Board to issue a Registered Barber License.
