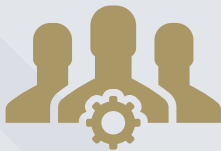

## PROJECTED JOB GROWTH

Employment of interior designers is projected to grow 4 percent from 2018 to 2028, about as fast as the average for all occupations. Designers will be needed to respond to consumers' expectations that the interiors of homes and offices meet required state and local codes, as well as certain conditions, such as being environmentally friendly and more easily accessible.
