Thank you for your letter of June 30, 2011, notifying the Commission on Colleges that Wake Technical Community College terminated, effective July 1, 2011, the Computer Information Technology, one year diploma, currently being offered at:

N.C. Correctional Institute for Women
Raleigh NC

As a result of budget cuts with the N.C. Department of Corrections, Wake Tech must terminate this diploma program as of July 1, 2011. Students and faculty members were notified by the N.C. Department of Corrections and Wake Tech. The faculty member connected with this program will return to the main campus and teach courses in the Computer Information Technology associate degree program.

Students currently enrolled in the program will be allowed to complete the diploma when they are released from this facility. Students do not have access to the internet so they cannot complete courses online.
