Thank you for your letter of November 4, 2011, providing information concerning a new certificate program and the Career and College Promise Program, effective January 2012.

Emergency Medical Science: Emergency Medical Technician Certificate

The College currently offers the A.A.S. degree in EMS. The Emergency Medical Technician Certificate is thus not a significant departure from programs currently offered and does not constitute a substantive change. **We acknowledge the information, will add it to our files, and request no further information.**

Career and College Promise Program

Effective January 2012, this program will replace the Huskins and Learn and Earn Programs. Details concerning the state mandated program were provided. The program offers select high school students the opportunity to earn college credits while still enrolled in high school. Courses in the following programs will be a part of the program and will be taught at the College's campuses and at Fuquay-Varina High School (the College provided notification in a letter, dated June 8, 2011, that 25-49% of courses in a program is offered at the site).
