Thank you for your letter of December 19, 2014, notifying the Commission that effective spring semester 2015, students at the North Campus off-campus instructional site can complete 25-49% of the requirements for the following programs:

Web Technologies A25290A	21 credit hours out of 70 (30.0%)
Criminal Justice Technology A55180	18 credit hours out of 64 (28.1%)
Nursing A45110	23 credit hours out of 72 (31.9%)

**We accept notification of the offering of 25-49% of the credits at the off-campus instructional site (North Campus) and request no additional information.**

Your letter indicated that the institution intends to offer greater than fifty percent (50%) of the credits for several programs beginning fall semester 2015. Please be aware that when 50% or more of the credits in a program are available at the site, a prospectus for approval of the site should be submitted at least three months prior to reaching the 50% point.
