Thank you for your letter of June 16, 2015, notifying the Commission of a new AAS in Facilities Technology: Multi-Trades degree. Your letter provided a course crosswalk delineating existing courses from other approved programs that are embedded in the new program; the new AAS degree is essentially a repackaging of currently-approved courses across related programs.

The institution intends to offer 40% of the credits leading toward the degree at the approved off-campus site beginning fall 2015:
