Dear Dr. Boone:

Thank you for your letter of March 29, 2016, notifying SACSCOC of your intention to offer the Associate in Applied Science in IT – Mobile Applications Developer degree program, effective fall 2016. Your letter provides information regarding other Computer Information Technology program realignment and name changes, effective fall 2016.

The new A.A.S. in IT – Mobile Applications Developer degree program replaces the Mobile Content Development Diploma program. The coursework in the new program comes from existing A.A.S. courses in Web Technologies, Simulation and Game Development, Computer Programming, and Computer Technology Integration.

Since the new degree program comes from existing approved courses, it does not represent a significant departure from approved programs. We acknowledge this information and will add it to the file.

Based on a statewide reorganization process by the North Carolina Community College System, Wake Technical Community College is realigning and renaming academic credentials in the Computer Information Technology division. These changes were initially reported to SACSCOC in a letter dated February 19, 2016.
