Thank you for your letter of October 5, 2016, notifying the Commission of your intent to offer the Associate of Applied Science in Facility Maintenance Technology degree program, effective spring 2017. The College currently offers related degree, diploma, and certificate programs in Air Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration; Construction Management Technology; Electrical Systems Technology; Plumbing, and Welding Technology. The A.A.S. in Facilities Maintenance Technology requires 68 credit hours. The curriculum for the program is a repackaging of existing courses from approved programs with the addition of four new courses (10 credit hours). Existing faculty and other resources are in place to support the new program. The program will be offered in a traditional, hybrid and online format. The College was approved for distance education in June 2000.

We accept notification of the new Associate of Applied Science in Facility Maintenance Technology degree program and require no additional information.
