Thank you for your letter of April 30, 2018, notifying the Commission of the intent to offer the Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) in Human Services Technology: Gerontology and Human Services Technology: Gerontology certificate, effective fall 2018. The institution currently offers the following related programs:

- A.A.S. in Human Services Technology
- A.A.S. in Human Services Technology: Substance Abuse
- A.A.S. in Human Services Technology: Mental Health

The program will be offered on the main campus. The institution currently offers a course in gerontology, and the new program will require three additional gerontology courses. Curriculum plans for the proposed associate degree and certificate were included. The program does not appear to be a substantive change requiring approval.
