Thank you for your letter of March 6, 2018, providing notification of the closure of eight programs and providing information concerning renaming and adding new academic credentials, effective fall 2018.

This letter will address the renaming and adding of programs. The closure of programs will be addressed in a separate letter. For future submissions, please provide a cover sheet in addition to the cover letter.

Re-Named Program

The name of the Associate in Applied Science degree in Accounting will be changed to the Associate in Applied Science degree in Accounting and Finance. The degree program was renamed by the North Carolina Community College System Office and applies to all 58 institutions. Currently enrolled students will be allowed to complete the currently named A.A.S. program or transfer to the newly named A.A.S. degree program in Accounting and Finance. Changes in name only of programs are not considered to be substantive changes.

New Certificate Programs, Effective Fall 2018

1. The new Marketing Certificate program is part of the existing A.A.S. degree in Business Administration: Marketing.
2. The new Sales Certificate program is part of the existing A.A.S. degree in Business Administration: Marketing.
3. The new Executive Leadership Certificate program is part of the existing A.A.S. degree in Business Administration: General Business Administration.
4. The new Marketing Research Certificate program is part of the existing A.A.S. degree in Business Administration: Marketing.
5. The new Advertising and Digital Media Certificate program is part of the existing A.A.S. degree program in Business Administration: Marketing.
6. The new Simulation Education Specialist Certificate program is part of the A.A.S. degree program in Healthcare Simulation Technology which was approved in a letter dated March 19, 2018.
7. The new Emergency Medical Science Certificate program is part of the existing A.A.S. degree program in Emergency Medical Science.
