Additional information was requested by the Commission via email; the response has been incorporated into the original submission.

Wake Technical Community College closed the Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree program in Mission Critical Operations, effective October 2018.

When an institution closes a program or instructional site, it has an affirmative obligation to seek closure approval from the Commission at the time the closure decision is made and prior to the cessation of instruction. The closure date is the date students are no longer admitted.

There are no students enrolled in the A.A.S. in Mission Critical Operations. The last degree completed in the program was in May 2018. The remaining student identified as a major in the program had not started the program and was notified of the termination in October 2018.

Faculty and staff members were notified of the program closure by the Dean of Applied Engineering Technology in October 2018. The faculty members associated with the program were being transferred to the A.A.S. degree programs in Electrical Systems Technology and Welding and the Diploma programs in Facilities Maintenance Technology and Plumbing. Staff members were being transferred to other programs within the division.
