Thank you for your letter of October 31, 2012, providing information which we requested in our letter to you, dated October 24, 2012, concerning the Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) Certificate.

Effective spring 2012, the program (one credit course) was terminated as a credit program and was moved to Continuing Education. The College was requested to provide information concerning how students and faculty were notified and disposition of faculty members teaching in the credit program.

The Continuing Education website was used to notify constituents about the administrative change to the program. By typing in BLET on the main web page, they were directed to the web site embedded within the Continuing Education division information. Faculty members teaching in the program were retained to teach it as a Continuing Education program and administrators connected with the program were transferred to the Continuing Education division.

We approve the termination of the BLET program as a credit program and its transfer to a continuing education program and request no further information.
